Gail Aiken was a spiritual leader and role-model for many at St. Joseph, especially the youth, where she demonstrated extraordinary dedication to her church and a profound love for the Lord.

Gail was known to all as a sweet, warm, and compassionate Christian woman. Top priority, second only to her Lord, was her family. She instilled a strong work ethic, confidence, and a passion for excellence in her children, reminding them that they could do all things through Christ. Love radiated from her eyes and her smiling face would

illuminate any room. She was a pillar of strength and the solid rock of her family.
