Bessie was employed at Duke Medical Center until her retirement in 2003 where she was a CNA in the emergency room for years doing what she loved to do helping people. During her retirement she was advent volunteer as Guardian ad Litem, Volunteer in Durham NC, volunteered with the Welcome Baby Program of Durham foster care support, Thanksgiving Durham Rescue Mission kitchen and several soup kitchen's.
