



Mr. Carlton Dale McNair

December 19, 1950 - December 31, 2022

Carlton Dale McNair, 72, son of the late Elwood E. McNair and Carrie Ellerbe McNair, died unexpectedly on December 31, 2022.

Carlton was born in Durham, North Carolina on December 19, 1950, and went to Durham Public Schools. He graduated from Hillside High School in 1968. Carlton attended Duke University and Shaw University and received a bachelor's degree in mathematics from Shaw in 1972.

He was a member of Mt. Vernon Baptist Church. He was a computer programmer and retired as a business and technology computer analyst in the Information Technology Department at N.C. Central University.

Carlton is survived by his sister, Eltonza M. (Paul) Brown; his niece, Caroline B. (Jamil) Johnson; five beloved grandnephews and grandnieces; a number of dear cousins; and other relatives and faithful friends.

The family will hold a private graveside service. The public is invited to a memorial service Thursday, February 16, 2023, at noon at Mount Vernon Baptist Church, 1007 S. Roxboro St., Durham, the Reverend Jerome J. Washington presiding.
