Mrs. Lillie Paulette Thorpe was born in Durham, North Carolina on July 31, 1945 to Johnny and Pauline Toomer who preceded her in death. She was also preceded in death by Edward Thorpe to whom she was married for thirty years. On the evening of Saturday, July 4, 2020, Paulette transitioned from this earthly life and entered into her eternal rest.

Paulette attended Hillside High School and graduated in 1963. Post-graduation, she attended Watts Hospital Nurse's Assistant Program and graduated in 1968. She spent her working career at Watts Hospital and Durham Regional Hospital retiring in February 2006. While employed at Durham Regional she was in charge of the Newborn Nursery for many years. Her knowledge and gentle spirit made it easy for the doctors and fellow nurses to consult with her and they respected her expertise with the infants.

At a very early age, Paulette joined New Bethel Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. L.W. Reid. Later, she moved her membership to The Shepherd's Flock Baptist Church and served on the floral club and kitchen committee. God was first in Paulette's life. She adored her family and cherished her church family. She will be missed by her many friends. Paulette had such a sweet spirit, she was humorous, had an infectious smile and a personality larger than life. Her sense of fashion was always impeccable. Whenever Paulette entered a room, her presence filled the room. She was an

avid NCCU Eagles, Duke Blue Devils and Dallas Cowboys fan.

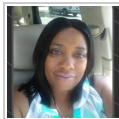
