Mrs. Bradley and her family relocated to Fayetteville, North Carolina, then moved to Durham, North Carolina where she met and married her husband, Thomas J. Bradley. Mrs. Bradley's parents died when she was very young. She was raised by her grandparents, David and Mary Johnson, with the assistance of her aunt and uncle, Rev. Charlie and Annie McCoy.

Mrs. Bradley was a graduate of Whitted High School (later changed to Whitted Junior High). After high school, she worked as an In-home child care provider. With encouragement and help from her husband, she attended Durham Technical Institute, where she received her Licensed Practical Nurse Degree (LPN). Upon graduation, she was employed with Duke Hospital as a LPN. She worked for Duke for twenty years until her retirement.
