Mrs. Rosa Odella Bass Harris, the daughter of the late Mr. Howard Samuel Bass and Mrs. Luthennie Hayes Bass was born in Person County, North Carolina on February 21, 1938.

At an early age, she professed a hope in Christ and joined Siloam Missionary Baptist Church. She was a faithful and supportive member.
