Sandra was a member of Agape Christian Church, Inc., formerly known as Palmers Memorial Holiness Church, which she was then led by the late Pastor Roy C. Belon. As being a member of the church, Sandra was a participating member of the choir, and various activities and programs. Sandra was known for being dressed to the "T" and being "blinged out". Her cooking was second to none and everyone could agree. She was known for her famous Potato Salad and Turkey Wings.


